



#### Dear Diver,

Thank you for booking your Search and Rescue speciality, a great fun course with loads of useful tips and ways of recovering those valuable items you may have dropped during a dive or even to go searching for lost treasure!

The dives will be conducted at <u>Mercers Lake</u>. If you are not sure of the dates you have booked then you can find them on your booking confirmation that you will have received by e-mail on the day you booked the course. Directions to the dive site can be found at the end of this document. Please ensure that you fill out the <u>PADI Medical Form</u> before your course.

We will meet you at the dive site at 9:30am and aim to be finished around 3pm both days. If you need to change your dates please give us at least one week notice by dropping us an e-mail us at <a href="mailto:info@oysterdiving.com">info@oysterdiving.com</a> (subject to availability).

Please bring along £15 entry fee per day, your log book, swimwear, warm clothes and some money for air (£5 per fill), food and beverages. Please note that we can only accept cash for air fills!

Once certified, your card will be automatically be uploaded to your PADI app, and you will be send a temporary card through your email. If you would like a physical card, you will need to arrange it directly <a href="www.padi.com">www.padi.com</a>.

If you haven't done so already, we do recommend purchasing your own lift bag and compass. These are available through our <u>dive shop</u> and can be brought along to your session. Alternatively, you can always contact us if you wish to order any equipment.

Mercers Country Park Nutfield Marsh Rd Redhill RH1 4EU

#### **Facilities**

Cafe – serving hot drinks, and ice cream
Toilets
Plenty of parking
Changing facilities
Hot showers in men's and women's changing rooms
Exclusive Oyster Dive Lake, so not large groups from other dive schools
Multiple dive sites including boat dives

Entry Fee & Parking - £15

Air to fill scuba tank - £5 per fill (Cash only)

### **Directions**

5 minutes from both the Merstham and the Redhill train station, Mercers Lake is easily accessible from London and the South East.

## From M23 (Brighton):

Follow the A23 North to the M23, back onto the A23. Make a U-turn at Dean Lane (There is a big Starbucks coffee shop at the U-turn point!). Take the right lane to take the A23 exit towards Redhill. Drive through the town, taking a slight left at the mini-clock tower. Take the right at the small roundabout, keep following that road, until you see a sign that says Aqua Spot. Go through the gate, down the dirt road, and find your parking space!

### From A23 (London):

Get onto the A23 South. Take the right lane to take the A23 exit towards Redhill. Drive through the town, taking a slight left at the mini-clock tower.
